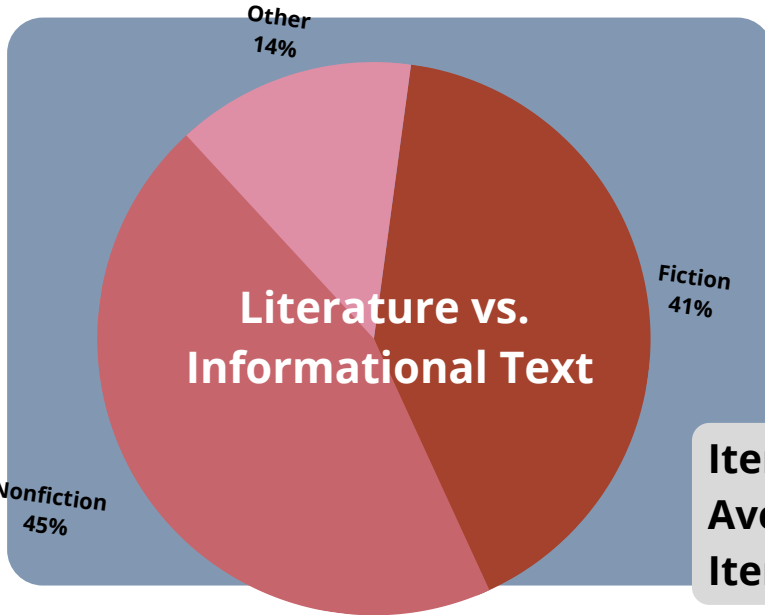

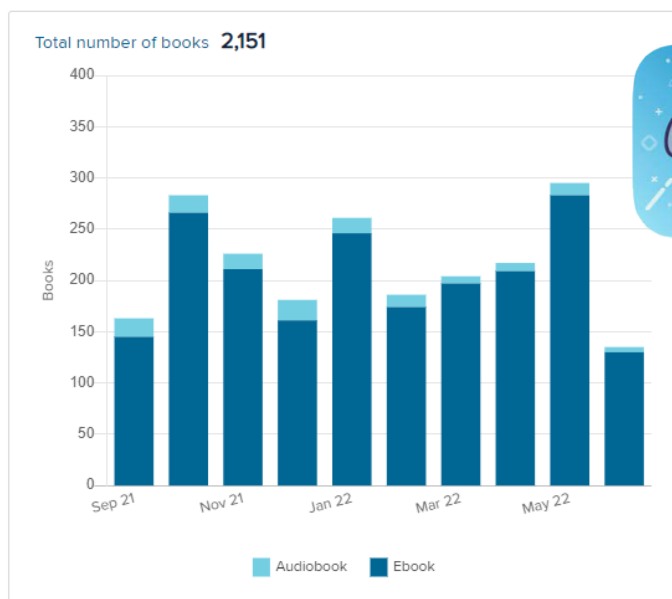

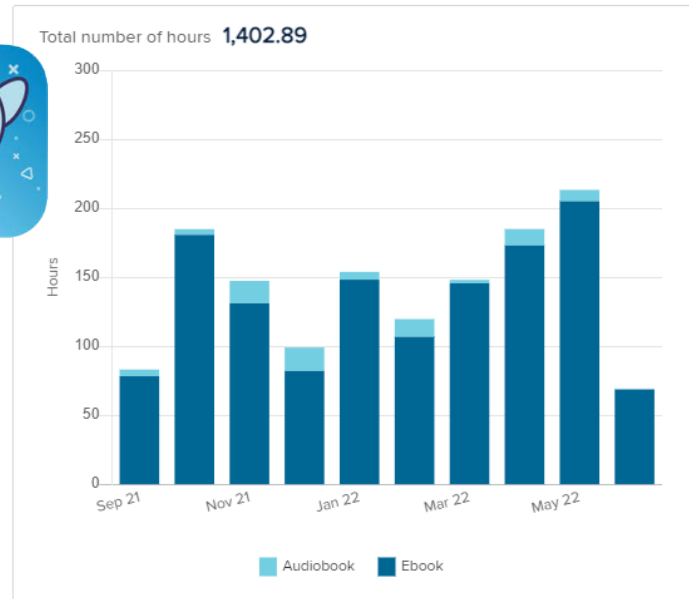

## Improvements

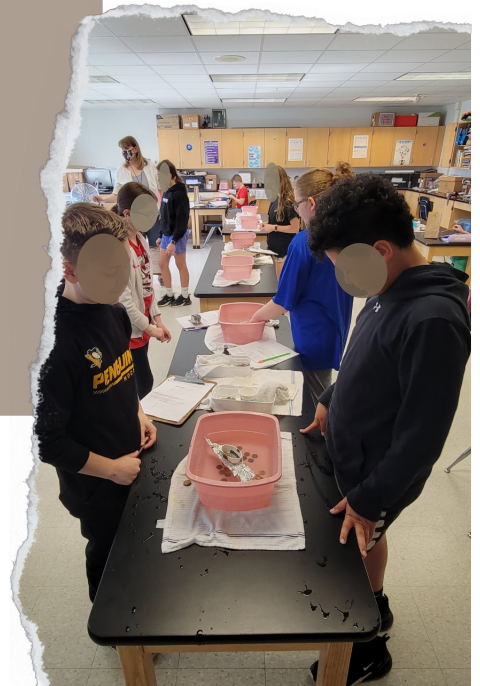
- Collaborated with teachers more than in previous years

- Successful library inventory of the entire middle school collection



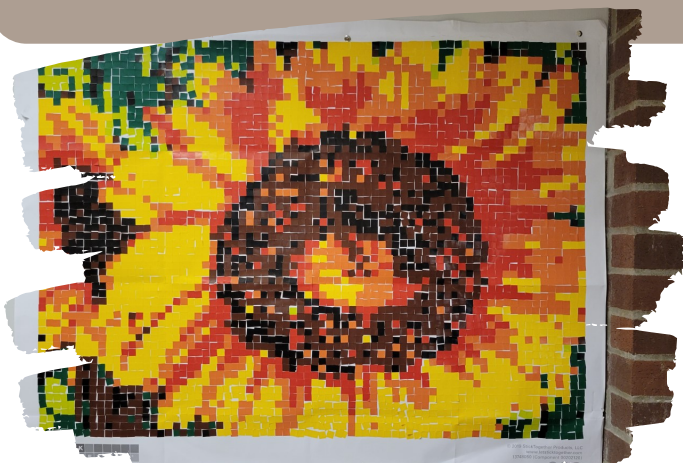
Library converted to the Poetry Café: 7th grade became poets and made spine poetry, blackout poems, and more!
