



LIBRARY PROGRAMS



- Birthday Books- PK 8th grade students receive a free book on their birthday
- **OPALS**-Students became familiar with OPALS, our new library automation software. They learned how to look up topics of interest and then locate them in the library
- **Scholastic Book Fair** huge success this year! Earned \$4,824.96 in Scholastic credit. We use this credit to purchase books for the library and to fund the birthday book program
- **Digital Citizenship** units for 4th & 5th grades- We utilize the curriculum developed by Common Sense Media. https://www.commonsense.org/education/digital-citizenship
- **SORA** we promoted Sora (eBook & audiobook platform) to all grades throughout the year, but it wasn't until June that we coached them through the SORA logon process, using school computers, that they really started using it. They LOVE it!
- **Summer reading BINGO** Students were given a BINGO card and promised a prize if they return it in the fall.
