Minutes ANNUAL REVIEW

SPECIAL EDUCATION: His current 15:1 placement is appropriate. Reviewed IEP with mom over the phone and she agreed to the findings. He lacks motivation and is easily distracted. He zones out and fidgets often. He does not self-initiate tasks. He does seem to want to please adults. He can lose a pencil in record time. He has difficulty organizing and accessing his materials. He speaks very quietly and has a naturally raspy voice. He can be difficult to understand at times. He struggles to share out in whole group. He doesn't always communicate effectively. Reading fluency is at a 2nd grade instructional level. Listening and reading comprehension and recall is poor. He avoids writing and it is difficult for him. He is working on spelling. He is slightly more interested in typing. He prefers an adult to scribe for him. He is working on the 2nd grade direct math instruction. He can do basic calculations without regrouping. He plugs in numbers correctly on a calculator. Benefits from accommodation of a calculator. Socially he has friends. Hygiene is a concern and that was discussed with mom on the phone. Mom reported he has nighttime enuresis. During free time he prefers an electronic device then interpersonal interaction. ADHD, asthma and seasonal allergies per last IEP. Previous IEP noted glasses. He is no longer wearing work boots all the time, so that is an improvement. He is wearing sneakers.

GENERAL EDUCATION: He plays well with others during outdoor recess. Often talks about video games. He loves doing the lego sets in the classroom. He wants to do the legos by himself. He doesn't follow our routines very well. He needs daily reminders. He often forgets his backpack and does not access his materials. He forgets clothing items throughout the school. Every morning he asks what task he should be doing though it is the same every day. He doesn't participate in science and social studies as well as other 15:1 students. He relies heavily on the TA for support for science and social studies. Science notes are scribed for him or written in highlighter. AIS Math is inconsistent. ELA AIS he does not enjoy. He needs constant refocusing. He is super sweet. He prefers small group instruction and prefers that over whole group instruction. He plays video games with this family.

PHYSICAL THERAPY: He can do stairs with alternating feet with prompting. Working on balance, endurance, and core strength. He did 4 sit ups in 30 seconds and this was challenging for him. He was able to do a V up. He did a wall sit for 18 seconds. He appears to have poor ankle strength.

SPEECH THERAPY: He is very social. He was pleasant during testing. He was easily redirected. Articulation was within normal limits. The only sound he struggled with was ending –ing. Language will be an area of focus. We can also work on him projecting better. Vocabulary is an area of deficit in the severe names. He struggled with memory. It was difficult for him to define words. He showed grammar issues. He could provide some synonyms. Struggled with listening comprehension activities. He was very distractible. He struggled with repeating sentences.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY: He needed multiple sessions. Perceptual skills are a strength for him. He had strong visual discrimination skills. He was above average with identifying which one is different. He struggled with visual sequential memory. He had difficulty with abstract visual closure. Fine motor skills were well below average. He can zip his jacket. He cannot tie his shoes. He was not able to copy designs. Letter formation is recognizable in context. Letter A is the most illegible. He struggles with nearpoint copying. He often overlaps/gaps lines in letters. Legibility is poor.

Annual review: student was not able to articulate specific details about likes/ dislikes at school. She did report to liking TV time in afterschool hours. Dad Minutes reported he thought transition to Edison was 'good' but that he was a bit concerned about science grade. Special Ed. teacher reported that she enjoys having student in class. Student consistently works hard and tries her best. She is well prepared for classes and willingly accepts help offered to her. She does much better with reading comprehension when 1) materials are read to her and 2) when opportunity to discuss content is available to her. New material needs much rehearsal and review for comprehension. Her organization of lengthy writing needs support also. Socially, she continues to present as extremely quiet in the larger classroom setting. She also may not want to share in the larger group in spite of maybe knowing the correct answer. This tendency will be a focus of a transition plan for student to increase her levels of comfort with interactions. Transition planning around a possible career in culinary arts was reported on. Science teacher reported that he also enjoys having student in class, but that student is very quiet and will not ask questions when she has them. Student also doesn't do homework corrections which could be helping her grade. She currently owes a cell coloring lab which is affecting her grade. She is encouraged to make this lab up. Quiz and test grades are also a bit low. However, with corrections, and made-up work, student should be able to pass course. In speech, student is reported to still need work in both comprehension strategies and vocabulary development. Student was noted to be making strong progress in sessions but continues to be recommended for services. Student's goals, accommodations, modifications and transitional needs were all reviewed and agreed to. Finally, regarding second language requirements, student's abilities and struggles related to comprehension of primary language, her speech and language involvement, and her learning profile all led CSE to agree to dismiss student from ESL requirements. Parent was in agreement with this recommendation. School counselor reported that student will most likely be gaining possibly 7 credits by end of freshman year.

Minutes Annual/ Re-evaluation review: student reported to CSE that 'this year was better than last year" because he 'hasn't gotten into trouble as much'. He also likes pre-algebra best and living environment is reported to be his most difficult task because of the data collection involved in the labs. Outside of the school day, student currently is involved in the wrestling team, and he enjoys football and track and watching football. He also enjoys hanging with his friends and playing video games (play station). After high school, student is considering a career in a branch of the armed services. His employment history includes helping his dad in the past in his plumbing job. School psychologist reported out on classroom observations completed for part of re-evaluation. His strengths and weaknesses were reviewed and discussed in detail. His special ed. substitute teacher reported that in math student is usually good about asking for help but sometimes struggles with accepting corrections and feedback offered to him. He also is inconsistent in his work performance, may tend to be somewhat distracted or verbally/ chatty with peers which becomes a deterrent to positive academic environment. His science teacher reported that student's labs were stronger than quizzes/tests. Student is in good standing to pass class, but he is encouraged to prepare for Regents exam in order to pass. His school counselor reported that student should have 7 credits by the end of this school year. As he is exempt from Spanish, student will work on other additional credits next semester. In January he will take Living Environment Regents in January and Algebra Regents in June. Student's accommodations and modifications were reviewed and agreed to.

Minutes RE EVALUATION/ANNUAL

Psychologist reviewed findings of the evaluation. The student earned a Full Scale IQ of 82 in the Low Average range consistent with previous reports. Her academic achievement ranged from extremely low to low average. Reading and math skills were a significant weakness compared to same-age peers. She expressed positive feelings about her teachers. Recommends that she continues to qualify as a student with a learning disability.

General education teacher reports she is sweet and happy. She will often sit and wait for assistance rather than asking for help. Attendance is a concern. She hasn't made close friends in the class but is friendly with students. Homework completion is inconsistent. She needs to self-initiate tasks in the classroom and become less reliant on teacher prompting.

Minutes GENERAL EDUCATION, Nicole Rosno: Before break he was off with his focus and behavior. The student reported he wasn't taking his medication. Mom reported the doctor was changing his medication. He is a bright, smart boy. Huge growth since she was his teacher in 2nd grade. His ability to focus, complete work, and socialize has improved. The beginning of the year was amazing. He was completing homework; his grades were excellent. The change started at the end of November. He is getting frustrated, hiding under his desk, scribbling on his paper, ripping his paper. Reports he does not like writing. He loves math and solves problems "his own way" but he is usually correct. He is a mental math thinker. He gets frustrated when required to show his work. Homework hasn't been completed. His hygiene is poor. He is coming into school very tired. Spoke with Mom about all these concerns. He is very sweet, respectful, and likes to follow the rules. He gets frustrated when others are following the rules and he doesn't respond appropriately. He can push other kids or pretend he is going to bite them. He will take a deep breath and state that he needs to take a break. He gets teary eyed. He will walk down the hall and then talk about the incident when he returns. He needs extended time, prompting, breaks. His grades are going downhill and not as good as he should be. He is very capable. Even copying notes is not preferred. Outside recess is great. Inside recess he asks the teacher to play rather than peers. He needs assistance finding peers to play with. SPECIAL EDUCATION, Cheryl Hayes: Works in the room. Confirms teacher observations. He barely needed any assistance at the beginning of the year.

Lately he has needed more refocusing. 4-5 times within a half hour period. He often fidgets. He is scribbling and using big sloppy handwriting. SPEECH, Kaitlin Osburn: He is seen twice a week for articulation goals. His social skills have improved in a group setting. He tries to control others through the teacher. Wants speech to talk to peers for him. Observes some attention seeking behaviors in speech. Generally, he works hard in speech and is aware of his goals. He can produce /r/ sound at the sentence in a structured task, but he isn't generalizing to conversations. Recommending remove speech from the 504 plan. Will move him to speech improvement 1 x week in a group.

PARENT: Silly play is still overstimulating for him. He is more receptive to redirection. He isn't wearing the hearing aides at home. He will wear them on the bus ride home. He associates the hearing aides at school. He is talking more at home. He is using more signs that I don't know. Requested a packet of all the signs that he knows. He is getting frustrated at home when Mom doesn't understand him. He is taking Guanfacine AM and PM. He is following asleep on the bus. Smashed his tablet because he couldn't get it to work. He hurt his thumb so he was punching his thumb. He will scream and yell instead of asking for help. TEACHER OF THE DEAF, Molly Aiello: He is more receptive to redirection. His behaviors are much shorter in duration. He likes to know what is coming next. Informed Mom that she sent an email to get her log in to google classroom. Has been posting videos in the google classroom of signs he is learning. SPECIAL EDUCATION, Jenn Jadoski: He has full adult proximity in the classroom. Sometimes he will go under the table. He will look at you and grin. Showed him the sign for work. Guided him to the table and put the ipad in front of him and he got to work. The first/then card helps him understand the expectation for the schedule.

GENERAL EDUCATION, Gina Margeson: He is in the general education classroom most in the afternoon. He is checking his visual schedule on his own. Since starting medication there hasn't been a need to call for help. He will misbehave if there is not an adult right with him. He was rolling himself up in he carpet, poking another child. Another child moved away. He got upset the child moved away and started throwing objects at her. This was also the day he didn't have medication. Yesterday, he copied a sentence during writing. He raised his hand to share and waited his turn.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY, Connie Lucia: He is making progress with forming letters, numbers, and cutting. He will pick manipulatives for free choice time using the picture cards. He does like to spin and will sometimes pick the swing. He is doing a great job in OT.

SPEECH THERAPY, Kaitlin Osburn: Seated across from him at the table for visual aids. Since medication he is more engaged with materials in speech and he is more appropriate. He is improving with turn taking. Working on playing cooperative board games. He wants to play he isn't throwing the materials or destroying them.

PHYSICAL THERAPY, Patrick Thomas: His free choice activity is usually the swing. He also loves to ride the tricycle in the hallway. He is better at being redirected. His focus has been better since the medication. He does need breaks during the therapy session.

CSE CHAIRPERSON, Megan Molina: His annua review will be in May. Anticipate adding an interpreter to his IEP in May. I would like as much data as possible before making that recommendation. A district posting has been made looking to hire a teacher aide with ASL capabilities.

Parent: Things are pretty much OK at home. Recently come through some struggles with homework. He can be disrespectful, not listen and refuse to complete homework. Guanfacine, AM. Sleep at home is fine. He used to nap every day after school. Now he does inconsistently. He sometimes takes a nap during the weekend.

Teacher: He is starting to seek out friends at playtime. He enjoys playing with another student. He wants all the toys for himself. He struggles with sharing. He will tell me if someone is upset in the room. Concerned that academics don't seem to be improving. He often sleeps in the afternoon. He misses instruction. Work is modified and reduced. Lately refusal behavior has been more intense. He refused to complete the curriculum-based assessment. He cries almost daily and is often upset. He does know the routine and follows it. Transitions occur every 20-30 minutes. Usually sleeps at 11:30 after lunch. He falls asleep when the teacher is reading a story. He goes into a deep sleep.

Occupational therapy he is showing improvement overall. January has been an inconsistent month for him. Speech therapy notes some refusal. Today he refused to do something, and he sat down on the floor. He redirects more easily.
